

CANADA 150 Grant

Deadline: May 4, 2017 (extended until funds are depleted)

The Municipality of the District of Lunenburg offers a Canada 150 Grant to assist community organizations in the delivery of a Canada 150 event/celebration.



Funding Use

- A community event/celebration that recognizes Canada 150

Eligibility

- Must be a not-for-profit organization (does not have to be registered with Joint Stocks) that serves the residents of the Municipality of the District of Lunenburg
- A public event that honours our accomplishments, celebrates our identity or builds on our future and builds a sense of pride in community or demonstrates our vibrant past and promising future. (see supported and not supported list below)
- Demonstrates financial assistance is needed
- Can be an addition to an existing event or program (i.e. Canada Day festivities)
- Project application must be received by **May 4, 2017 (extended until funds are depleted)**
- Event/celebration must be completed by December 31, 2017
- Municipality reserves the right to determine the number of Canada 150 events/celebrations it will support throughout the Region

Procedures

- A completed, signed application form is required
- Only one application per organization for Canada 150 will be considered
- Applicants must submit a proposed program budget, including total revenues from all sources
- Applicants must include a profile of the organization, including the people/community to be served by the event and explain how the event will be of benefit to the community
- Applications will be reviewed by the Director of Recreation Services
- Applicants must recognize the Municipality of the District of Lunenburg as a participating sponsor (e.g. brochures, programs, advertisements)

Funding

- Applicants are eligible for **75% of the event/celebration costs up to a maximum of \$1,000**
- 75% of the grant may be issued in advance of the event/celebration with sufficient documentation

Supported Activities: arts and culture, sports and active living, history and heritage, youth engagement, fireworks

Not Supported: alcoholic beverages, advocacy activities, fundraising projects, events with closed membership.

Note: The Municipality may provide Canada 150 “give away” items free of charge to any community event recognizing Canada 150 (while supplies last). The items and quantity will be determined by the expected number of participants and at the discretion of Recreation Staff.
