WHAT IS THE SIZE OF YOUR PUNT/TENDER? (maximum size 12 feet for floating dock) _____ feet

The following are the rules for leasing dock spots at the Saw Pit Wharf Facility:

- *Punts/Tenders that are 12 feet and under, a picture may be required.*
- *Only one dock space per household is allowed.*
- *There will be no subletting of a dock space, or you may lose the privilege of leasing a space.*
- *The lease of a dock space is seasonal and begins **June 1st** and ends September 30th yearly.*
- *The current rental of a dock spot is **\$125 + HST** per season (these rates are subject to change without notice).*
- *Only those 19 years of age or over can make application for a permit.*
- *Use is at your own risk. The Municipality of the District of Lunenburg is not responsible for damages or lose of your punt/tender or any equipment or articles. The Municipality of the District of Lunenburg shall not be responsible for any damages to persons, or equipment caused by natural weather events and/or other acts of God.*
- ***Application does not guarantee dock spot, your application fee will be refunded.***
- ***In the event of adverse weather MODL reserves the right to remove the floating dock system prior to September 30th and may decide, depending on timing of the event, to not reinstall for the remainder of the season. No refunds will be issued.***
